## 4<sup>th</sup> Annual MLK Day Celebration and Service Fair

The 4<sup>th</sup> Annual MLK Day Celebration and Service Fair will be one of hundreds of activities held in states and cities nationwide to honor the legacy of Dr. King. In 1994, Congress passed the King Holiday and Service Act designating the King Holiday as a national day of volunteer service and directing the Kind Center and Corporation for National and Community Service to carry out a day of service reflecting Dr. King's life and teachings.

The Opening Celebration, beginning at 9am will include proclamation readings and presentations by local public officials and leaders.

The Service Fair, beginning promptly at 10am will host a variety of booths each engaging participants in different service activities, all of which are suitable for children and adults. Projects include:

- Assembling bagged lunches for the Frederick Rescue Mission
- Making Valentine Day cards for seniors
- Making friendship bracelets for children in the hospital
- And many others!

Participants are welcome to drop in anytime between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Stop by on your lunch break or stay for several hours. The day will culminate with a showing of "My Friend, Martin" a film about Martin Luther King, Jr. at 1 p.m.

The event is free and all ages are welcome to attend – adults, families, children, and groups of all kind. Children under the age of 14 must be supervised by an adult.

If you would like to volunteer but do not want to attend the service fair, Volunteer Frederick has set up an additional volunteer project at Habitat ReStore. They are looking for volunteers to build racks which will hold windows and doors for easy navigation. Pre-registration for this volunteer opportunity is required.
