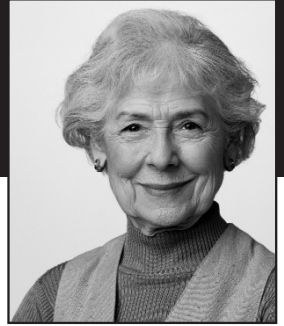


I already volunteer. Why should I join **RSVP?**

If you are currently volunteering or affiliated with a service organization or church, RSVP benefits both you and your community in the following ways:

- By joining the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP), you become part of one of the largest volunteer efforts in the nation. **RSVP is part of Senior Corps, a network of national service programs that provides Americans 55 and older the opportunity to apply their life experience to meeting critical community needs.**
- Your hours of service and involvement in the community are documented by RSVP, reported to Congress and indicate to our elected officials the extent to which older Americans are making a difference in their communities.
- The high level of volunteerism by this segment of the population has been a strong lobbying factor for preserving federally funded programs-like Medicare and Social Security-which help older adults.
- Recognition for your volunteer accomplishments and those of your organization through local media outlets such the Gazette, Most! Magazine and the Frederick News Post.
- Nomination for state and national recognition awards such as "Maryland You Are Beautiful," the MD Senior Citizens Hall of Fame , the Governor's Volunteer and Service Awards and the President's Award.
- Free supplemental automobile liability insurance coverage to and from volunteer assignments.
- Volunteer liability and personal injury insurance coverage.
- Networking and the fun of RSVP recognition events.
- Opportunities to participate in emergency preparedness trainings and drills.
- Programs on topics of interest to retirees.
- Personalized consultation and placement, should you at some point be interested in exploring new volunteer opportunities.
